

MEETING MONDAY TO ARRANGE FOR 1936 STAMPEDE

The officially appointed committee consists of A. L. Garbett, June Kendall, Herman W. McCune, M. M. O'Gara, Frank E. Wanlass, Gilbert Bailey and Dr. P. L. Jones. This group is to name their own chairman, who will be the chairman of the entire celebration.

The services of the Colborn-Sorenson Rodeo company, a leading carnival company and leading entertainers have been secured for the Stampede already and from the present enthusiasm being shown, the celebration will easily surpass the 1935 stampede and encampede.
