

Queen To Be Selected Soon

"Queen of the Ute Stampede" is the title to be placed on the representative girl of Nephi to be selected during the near future, according to an announcement made Thursday by Dr. P. L. Jones, head of the general committee.

A special committee to handle the work of selecting the Stampede queen was named at a recent meeting of the general committee. Erma Lomax heads the committee which is composed of Itha Parkes, Pearl Nielsen, and Mrs. Harriet Golden. This group will handle the affair of selecting the queen voting, and counting.

Any person desiring to sponsor a candidate to vie for the honor of Stampede queen, or any girl wishing to vie for the honor, must present the name of the girl as a candidate to the chairman of the committee. Each candidate must have the endorsement of ten representative citizens of the city to be entered in the contest. No name will be placed on the list for voting unless it is accompanied by the ten signatures.

The names must be in the hands of a member of the committee in charge of the selection of the queen by next Wednesday evening, June 10 at 6 P. M. The complete list of candidates together with the method to be used in voting will be released in the Times-News of next week.
